CHAPTER - 1

RULES FOR ADMISSION TO ENGINEERING/PHARMACY DIPLOMA HOLDERS/SCIENCE GRADUATES (with Mathematics in 10+2 Exam) THROUGH LATERAL ENTRY IN SECOND YEAR (THIRD SEMESTER) OF UNDER GRADUATE COURSES IN ENGINEERING/TECHNOLOGY APPROVED BY AICTE AND PHARMACY APPROVED BY PCI IN AUTONOMOUS, GOVT. AIDED & SELF FINANCING INSTITUTIONS IN MP.

w.e.f. Session 2023-24

1.1 General :

These rules may be called the Admission Rules for admission to Engineering/Pharmacy Diploma holders/Science Graduates (with Mathematics in 10+2 Exam in 10+2 Exam) through lateral entry in second year (Third semester) of under graduate courses in Engineering/Technology and Pharmacy in autonomous, govt. aided, & self financing engineering/pharmacy institutions.

1.2 Definitions:

In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- (a) "AICTE" means All India Council for Technical Education a statutory body established by All India Council for Technical Education Act, 1987;
- (b) "Competent Authority" means any authority as authorized by the State Government in this behalf;
- (c) "CTE" means Commissioner of Technical Education Madhya Pradesh;
- (d) "Fee" means all fees including tuition fee and development charges;
- (e) "Principal" means Head of institution;
- (f) "Qualifying Examination" means the examination of the minimum qualification, passing of which entitles one to seek admission into the relevant Professional Courses as prescribed in these rules;
- (g) "Single Window System" means a system by which available seats in all the institutions are offered through Common Centralized Counselling or Decentralize Online Counselling to qualified candidates in order of merit in the Common Entrance Test;
- (h) 'RGPV' means Rajeev Gandhi Prodyogiki Vishwavidhyalaya;
- (i) 'Category' means one of the four categories viz. 'Unreserved (UR)', 'Scheduled Caste (SC)', 'Scheduled Tribe (ST)' or 'Other Backward Classes (excluding creamy layer) (OBC)';
- (j) 'Open Seats' means Female & Male Candidates.
- (k) F' Seats means Female Candidate.
- (l) 'M.P. Seats' means seats reserved for the residents of State of Madhya Pradesh as provided in Rule;
- (m) 'M.P.' means State of Madhya Pradesh as formed on 01-11-2000.

- (n) 'PCI' means Pharmacy Council of India
- (o) The words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the rule.

1.3 Applicability:–

These rules shall be applicable to autonomous, Govt. aided, & self financing Technical institutions which are conducting Under Graduate courses/ programmes in Engineering, Technology sanctioned and approved by AICTE and Pharmacy courses duly sanctioned and approved by PCI from time to time.

1.4 Admission Rules:–

Admission shall be as under:

1.4.1 Availability of seats (Extent of Lateral Entry):–

- (a) Maximum 10 percent seats over and above the sanctioned intake (supernumerary) of previous academic year shall be available for admission through lateral entry scheme in second year Engineering degree (B.E./B.Tech) course and in second year Pharmacy degree (B.Pharmacy) course.

These seats shall be available for MP domicile candidates only. The details of Institutions, branches and seats shall be available on the website of Counselling Authority i.e. <https://dte.mponline.gov.in>.

- (b) The unfilled / vacant seats of previous academic year of first year will also be available for admission in lateral entry scheme.

1.4.2 Allocation/ Reservation of seats-

16%, 20% and 14% of the seats of MP Quota are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Other Backward Classes (excluding Creamy Layer) OBC categories respectively in institutions declared autonomous by the State Government, Government Aided Institutions and Self-Financing Autonomous Institutions (Universities).

NOTE:

- (a) A candidate can claim reservation under only one of the various reserved categories.
- (b) A candidate, claiming reservation under a reserved category shall have to produce relevant certificate/certificates in proforma prescribed by the Government of MP.

1.4.2.1. Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) Category of Madhya Pradesh:

A candidate claiming to be either of SC or ST categories of MP shall have to produce a certificate from the competent authority in **Proforma-1** (Annexure-1) as given in this rule book. (Vide MP

Government GAD order No. F.7-2/96 आ.प्र./1) भोपाल, दिनांक 01-08-1996 and as per latest order issued by the Govt. of M.P.

1.4.2.2 OBC category of Madhya Pradesh

A candidate claiming reservation under OBC (excluding creamy layer) category shall have to produce a certificate at the time of verification of documents issued by the competent authority in **Proforma-2** (Annexure-2) as given in the rule book. (Vide MP Government GAD order No. F/7-2/96 आ.प्र./1, भोपाल, दिनांक 12.03.1997 and order no. ,F-7-2/96 आ.प्र./1, भोपाल, दिनांक 06.07.2000 and as per latest order issued by the Govt. of M.P. regarding creamy layer. The candidate should also bring an income certificate at the time of verification of documents regarding his/her family's income from the Competent Authority or self declaration regarding income as prescribed by GAD, Government of M.P. by his circular no. सी-3-7-2013-3-एक, दिनांक 25/09/2014 (**Proforma-10**) (Annexure -6) and stating that his/her parents do not come under creamy layer if OBC certificate is issued before **30th April, 2020.**

1.4.2.3 Reservation for Female candidates:

30% seats in each category viz. UR, SC, ST and OBC shall be reserved for female candidates of Madhya Pradesh in Govt., Govt. aided, & self financing institutions. This reservation shall be a compartmentalized horizontal reservation.

Seats remaining vacant in female quota of a category shall be filled by converting such seats into Open Quota (OP) of the same category.

However if even after this conversion the Open Quota (OP) of that category does not get filled then these vacancies shall be filled by converting them into Open Quota (OP) of other categories as per the procedure laid down in Rule.

1.5 Eligibility for admission-

1.5.1 As per the guidelines prescribed by AICTE /PCI and State Government.

1.5.2 The candidates should be an Indian national.

1.5.3 Educational qualifications:

- (i) **A degree programme in Engineering at the second year (Third semester) level**

A Candidate must have passed a regular Three years / Two years (Through Lateral Entry) engineering diploma programme examination in ANY branch of Engineering/Technology from an Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC or from a foreign

University recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) or institute recognized by the concerned University as equivalent thereto, with minimum marks of 45 percent;

Eligibility criteria for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (Excluding creamy layer) of Madhya Pradesh as notified by the State Government shall be 40 percent in the aggregate marks in qualifying examination.

OR

Candidate must have passed B.Sc. Degree examination from a university recognized by the university grants commission with minimum 45 percent marks and have passed 10+2 examination with mathematics as a subject.

Eligibility criteria for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (Excluding creamy layer) of Madhya Pradesh as notified by the State Government shall be 40 percent in the aggregate marks in qualifying examination.

(ii) A Degree Programme in Pharmacy at the second year (Third Semester) level

Passed Diploma Pharmacy course from an institutions approved by the PCI u/s 12 of Pharmacy Act. 1948.

- 1.5.4** Weightage of 10 percent of the marks in the qualifying exam shall be given to those candidates who have been awarded **Gold Medal** in the National level Sports Competition. To obtained the above benefits candidates shall have to produce the certificate from Director, Department of Sports & Youth Welfare, and Government of Madhya Pradesh in specified **Proforma-9** (Annexure-5).

1.5.5 Domicile Requirements:

No candidate shall be selected for admission against the MP domicile seats unless;

1.6 Mode of selection-

In all professional institutions the procedure for admission shall be as under:-

Competent Authority shall invite the online applications and candidates shall be required to fill up online application.

The competent authority after receiving the application from candidates shall prepare and notify a merit list on the basis of percentages of aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination. In case, the percentages of aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination are equal, then merit will be decided by giving preference to the candidate who is older in age. If age is also same then merit will be decided by English alphabetical order of the candidate name.

Candidates getting benefits of weightage as included in **1.5.4** shall be placed below the candidate who has got the same marks in the merit but has not been given the above weightage.

Note:-

- 1.** All such candidate who has passed qualifying examination with grace marks are also eligible for admission, but grace marks will not be included for minimum percentage condition mentioned above.
- 2.** All such candidate whose qualifying examination marksheet are based on grading system has to produce conversion of grade to marks as per the conversion formula mentioned in their marksheet.

1.7 Procedure of Admission

Online Offcampus Admission Procedure:

It shall be conducted according to the provisions of Admission Rules, 2008 (amended from time to time) Published in the Madhya Pradesh Gazette (Extra ordinary) dated the 15th April, 2008.

1.8 General Information of admission:

- 1.8.1** The admission into all the colleges/institutes offering under graduate professional course in Engineering (including Technology) and Pharmacy shall be made by the competent authority through single window system in the order of merit on the basis of percentages of aggregate mark obtained in the qualifying examination.
- 1.8.2** Admission shall be done through Counselling on the basis of the common merit list. The programme of Counselling shall be published in various news papers and shall also be available on website of competent authority "*Commissioner Technical Education, M.P. Bhopal*" i.e. <https://dte.mponline.gov.in>. No separate call letters shall be sent to the candidates.
- 1.8.3 Original Documents:** During the Counselling process the documents presented by the candidates shall be verified with originals and original documents will be returned back to the candidates. However candidates need not to submit such original documents in the admitted institutions.

- 1.8.4** Transfer of institution in this course shall not be permitted.
- 1.8.5** All admissions shall be completed on or before the last date declared by the Competent Authority.

1.9 The sequence of admission shall be as under:

- 1.9.1** In the allotment of MP domiciled candidates seats, Candidates belonging to reserved category shall be Allotted Seats in the following order so that the reserved seats may be converted mutually in the following order: scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Class, Scheduled Tribes/Scheduled Castes.
- 1.9.2** After allocation of seats in the aforesaid counseling of reserved category, the vacant seats, if any, shall be converted in to unreserved seats and then the counseling for unreserved seats shall commence. Such candidates of reserved category, who have also secured place in the merit list of in reserved category, shall have the option to choose the institution/Branch of unreserved Category. If the candidates belonging to reserved category take admission against the unreserved category according to their merit, they shall be counted under unreserved category.
- 1.9.3** If seats remain vacant, after organizing one phase of centralized/Decentralized online counseling based on the merit list prepared on the basis of percentages of aggregate mark obtained in the qualifying examination of final year, they shall be filled as mentioned in the Admission Rules-2008 (As ammended) and/or counselling procedure declared by the Competent Authority.

1.10 Cancellation of Admission:

- (1) If at any stage it is found that a candidate has got admission in any institution on the basis of false or incorrect information or by hiding relevant facts or if at any time after admission it is found that the admission was given to the candidate due to some mistake or oversight, the admission granted to such a candidate shall be liable to be cancelled forthwith without any notice at any time during the course of his/her studies by the Principal of the institution or by Competent Authority.
- (2) Last date of admission in engineering course will be as per AICTE calendar for session 2023-24. If PCI declare last date of admission for session 2023-24 then it will be applicable for lateral B.pharmacy admission otherwise last date of admission will be as per AICTE calendar.
- (3) Vacancy arising (in particular class/category/compartment) due to cancellation of admission or due to non reporting of candidates by the stipulated date (as declared by the Competent Authority) in a particular Institution, shall be considered in the counselling in the following manner:- During the counselling, if seats are available, in that particular course, vacancy/vacancies arising due to above reasons shall be added directly to existing vacancy/vacancies and shall be available for allotment.

- (4) After the last date of admission, cancellation of admission shall only be done by the institution.

1.11 TUITION AND OTHER FEE-

Tuition fees and other fees shall be payable by the candidates as per order of Govt. of Madhya Pradesh as may be applicable from time to time.

1.12 Interepretation:

Norms, requirements and other conditions for admission to technical/professional courses are as per the guidelines issued by AICTE/PCI.

The Government of Madhya Pradesh shall be the final authority for deciding any matter in respect of policy regarding selection of candidates for admission. If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules for admission, the decision of the Government of MP shall be final and binding.

1.13 MODIFICATION TO RULES/PROCEDURES:

The Government of Madhya Pradesh reserves the right to amend any provision/rule/procedure for admission in the public interest and any modification so made shall be binding.

1.14 JURISDICTION:

In case of any dispute the jurisdiction shall be limited to the courts constituted and situated in Madhya Pradesh only.

2.1 Short Title and Commencement :

- (1) These rules may be called admission rules, 2008.

2.2 Definitions:

In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- (a) "Act" means the Madhya Pradesh Niji Vyavsayik Shikshan Sanstha (Pravesh Ka Viniyaman Avam Shulk Ka Nirdharan) Adhiniyam, 2007 (No. 21 of 2007);
- (b) "Admissions and Fee Regulatory Committee" means the Committee constituted by the State Government for the supervision and guidance of admission process and for the fixation of fee to be charged from candidates seeking admission in a professional educational institution;
- (c) "AICTE" means All India Council for Technical Education a statutory body established by All India Council for Technical Education Act, 1987;
- (d) "Common Entrance Test" means the entrance tests for admission in Various technical and professional courses conducted by an agency duly authorized by the State Government for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) "Competent Authority" means any authority as authorized by the State Government in this behalf;
- (f) "CTE" means Commissioner of Technical Education Madhya Pradesh;
- (g) "Fee" means all fees including tuition fee and development charges;
- (h) "Non resident Indian" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in clause (e) of Section 115c of the Income Tax Act, 1961 (43 of 1961).
- (i) "Principal" means Head of institution;
- (j) "Private Unaided Professional Institution" means the professional institutions which does not receive recurring aid or grant-in-aid form any State or Central Government;
- (k) "Professional Institution" means a college or institute including a private university established or incorporated by an Act of the State Legislature

or Constituent unit of a deemed university defined under section 3 of University Grant Commission Act, 1956;

- (l) "Qualifying Examination" means the examination of the minimum qualification, passing of which entitles one to seek admission into the relevant Professional Courses as prescribed in these rules;
- (m) "Single Window System" means a system by which available seats in all the institutions are offered through Common Centralized Counselling or Decentralize Online Conselling to qualified candidates in order of merit in the Common Entrance Test;
- (n) The words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act.

OTHER ABBREVIATIONS USED IN THIS RULE BOOK ARE:-

- (I) RGPV means Rajeev Gandhi Prodhoyogiki Vishwavidhyalaya, Bhopal;
- (II) 'M.P.' means State of Madhya Pradesh as formed on 01-11-2000.
- (III) 'PCI' means Pharmacy Council of India

2.3 Applicability –

These rules shall be applicable to unaided private Technical institutions which are conducting Under Graduate courses/ programmes in Engineering, Technology duly sanctioned and approved by AICTE and Pharmacy duly sanctioned and approved by PCI from time to time.

2.4 Admission rules -

Admission shall be as under–

2.4.1 Availability of seats (Extent of Lateral Entry)–

- (a) Maximum 10 percent seats over and above the sanctioned intake (supernumerary) of previous academic year shall be available for admission through lateral entry scheme in second year Engineering degree (B.E./B.Tech) course and Maximum 10 percent seats over and above the sanctioned intake (supernumerary) of previous academic year shall be available for admission through lateral entry scheme in second year Pharmacy degree (BPharmacy) course.

The details of Institutions, branches and seats shall be available on the website of Counselling Authority i.e. <https://dte.mponline.gov.in>.

- (b) The unfilled / vacant seats of previous academic year of first year will also be available for admission in lateral entry scheme.

2.4.2 Allocation/ Reservation of seats-

In every institution 16%, 20% and 14% of available seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to SC, ST and OBC categories (excluding creamy layer) respectively as notified by the state government in this regard for M.P. domicile only.

2.4.2.1 Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) Category of Madhya Pradesh:

A candidate claiming to be either of SC or ST category of MP shall have to produce a certificate from the competent authority in **Proforma-1**(Annexer-1) as given in this rule book. (Vide MP Government GAD order No. F.7-2/96 भोपाल, दिनांक 01-08-1996 and as per latest order issued by the Govt. of M.P.

2.4.2.2 OBC category of Madhya Pradesh

A candidate claiming reservation under OBC (excluding creamy layer) category shall have to produce a certificate at the time of verification of documents issued by the competent authority in **Proforma-2**(Annexer-1) as given in the rule book. (Vide MP Government GAD order No. F/7-2/96 आ.प्र./1, भोपाल, दिनांक 12.03.1997 and order no. ,F-7-2/96 आ. प्र./1, भोपाल, दिनांक 06.07.2000 and as per latest order issued by the Govt. of M.P. regarding creamy layer. The candidate should also bring an income certificate at the time of verification of documents regarding his/her family's income from the Competent Authority or self declaration regarding income as prescribed by GAD, Government of M.P. by his circular no. सी-3-7-2013-3-एक, दिनांक 25/09/2014 **(Proforma-10)** (Annexer-6) and stating that his/her parents do not come under creamy layer if OBC certificate is issued before **30th April, 2020**.

2.5 Eligibility for admission-

2.5.1 As per the guidelines prescribed by AICTE and State Government.

2.5.2 The candidates should be an Indian national.

2.5.3 Educational qualifications:

(i) A degree programme in Engineering at the second year (Third semester) level

A Candidate must have passed a regular Three years / Two years (Through Lateral Entry) engineering diploma programme examination in ANY branch of Engineering/Technology from an Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC or from a foreign University recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) or institute recognized by the concerned University as equivalent thereto, with minimum marks of 45 percent;

Eligibility criteria for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (Excluding creamy layer) of Madhya Pradesh as notified by the State Government shall be 40 percent in the aggregate marks in qualifying examination.

OR

Candidate must have passed B.Sc. Degree examination from a university recognized by the university grants commission with

minimum 45 percent marks and have passed 10+2 examination with mathematics as a subject.

Eligibility criteria for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (Excluding creamy layer) of Madhya Pradesh as notified by the State Government shall be 40 percent in the aggregate marks in qualifying examination.

(ii) A Degree Programme in Pharmacy at the second year (Third Semester) level

Passed Diploma Pharmacy course from an institutions approved by the PCI u/s 12 of Pharmacy Act. 1948.

2.5.4 Weightage of 10 percent of the marks in the qualifying exam shall be given to those candidates who have been awarded **Gold Medal** in the National level Sports Competition. To obtained the above benefits candidates shall have to produce the certificate from Director, Department of Sports & Youth Welfare, and Government of Madhya Pradesh in specified **Proforma-9** (Annexure-5).

2.5.5 Domicile Requirements:

No candidate belonging to SC, ST & OBC (Excluding Creamy Layer) category shall be selected for admission against the seats reserved for them unless

2.6 Mode of selection-

In case, the percentages of aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination are equal, then merit will be decided by giving preference to the candidate who is older in age. If age is also

same then merit will be decided by English alphabetical order of the candidate name.

Candidates getting benefits of weightage as included in **2.5.4** shall be placed below the candidate who has got the same marks in the merit but has not been given the above weightage.

Note:-

- 1.** All such candidate who has passed qualifying examination with grace marks are also eligible for admission, but grace marks will not be included for minimum percentage condition mentioned above.
- 2.** All such candidate whose qualifying examination marksheet are based on grading system has to produce conversion of grade to marks as per the conversion formula mentioned in their marksheet.

2.7 Procedure of Admission

Online Offcampus Admission Procedure:

In case it is decided to conduct counseling by online off campus system, it shall be conducted according to the provisions of Admission Rules, 2008 (amended from time to time) Published in the Madhya Pradesh Gazette (Extra ordinary) dated the 15th April, 2008.

2.8 General Information of admission:

- 2.8.1** The admission into all the colleges/institutes offering under graduate professional course in Engineering (including Technology) and Pharmacy shall be made by the competent authority through single window system in the order of merit on the basis of percentages of aggregate mark obtained in the qualifying examination.
- 2.8.2** Admission shall be done through Counselling on the basis of the common merit list. The programme of Counselling shall be published in various news papers and shall also be available on website of competent authority/Director Technical Education, M.P. Bhopal i.e. <https://dte.mponline.gov.in>. No separate call letters shall be sent to the candidates.
- 2.8.3 Original Documents:** During the Counselling process the documents presented by the candidates shall be verified with originals and original documents will be returned back to the candidates. However candidates need not to submit such original documents in the admitted institutions
- 2.8.4** Transfer of institution in this course shall not be permitted.
- 2.8.5** All admissions shall be completed on or before the last date declared by the Chancellor.

2.9 The sequence of admission shall be as under:

- 2.9.1** In the allotment of MP domiciled candidates seats, Candidates belonging to reserved category shall be called in counseling in the following order so that the reserved seats may be converted mutually in the following

order namely- scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Class, Scheduled Tribes/Scheduled Castes.

2.9.2 After allocation of seats in the aforesaid counseling of reserved category, the vacant seats, if any, shall be converted in to unreserved seats and then the counseling for unreserved seats shall commence. Such candidates of reserved category, who have also secured place in the merit list of in reserved category, shall have the option to choose the institution/Branch of unreserved Category. If the candidates belonging to reserved category take admission against the unreserved category according to their merit, they shall be counted under unreserved category.

2.9.3 If seats remain vacant, after organizing one phase of centralized / Decentralized online counseling based on the merit list prepared on the basis of percentages of aggregate mark obtained in the qualifying examination of final year, they shall be filled as mentioned in the Admission Rules-2008 (As ammended) and/or counselling procedure declared by the Competent Authority.

2.10 Cancellation of Admission:

(1) If at any stage it is found that a candidate has got admission in any institution on the basis of false or incorrect information or by hiding relevant facts or if at any time after admission it is found that the admission was given to the candidate due to some mistake or oversight, the admission granted to such a candidate shall be liable to be cancelled forthwith without any notice at any time during the course of his/her studies by the Principal of the institution or by Competent Authority.

(2) Last date of admission in engineering course will be as per AICTE calendar for session 2023-24. If PCI declare last date of admission for session 2023-24 then it will be applicable for lateral B.pharmacy admission otherwise last date of admission will be as per AICTE calendar.

(3) Vacancy arising (in particular class/category/compartment) due to cancellation of admission or due to non reporting of candidates by the stipulated date (as declared by the Competent Authority) in a particular Institution, shall be considered in the counselling in the following manner:-

During the counselling, if seats are available, in that particular course, vacancy/vacancies arising due to above reasons shall be added directly to existing vacancy/vacancies and shall be available for allotment.

(4) After the last date of admission, cancellation of admission shall only be done by the institution.

2.11 Tuition and other fees-

As prescribed by fee Regulatory committee constituted under the Act.

2.12 Modification to rules/procedures-

The Government of Madhya Pradesh reserves the rights to amend any provision/rules/procedure for admission in public interest and any modification so made shall be binding.

A candidate aggrieved with any contravention on the part of the Agency or any contravention of the provisions of the Act could make an application to the Committee pinpointing the cause of action and alleged lapse in following the procedure or provisions of the Act.

2.13 Interpretation-

Norms, requirements and other conditions for admission to technical/professional courses are as per the guidelines issued by AICTE/PCI.

The Government of Madhya Pradesh shall be the final authority for deciding any matter in respect of policy regarding selection of candidates for admission. If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules for admission, the decision of the Government of MP shall be final and binding.

2.14 Power to remove difficulties –

The Government of Madhya Pradesh shall be the final authority for deciding any matter in respect of policy regarding selection of candidates for admission. If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules for admission, the decision of the Government of Madhya Pradesh shall be final and binding.

2.15 Jurisdiction-

In case of any dispute the jurisdiction shall be limited to the courts constituted and situated in Madhya Pradesh only.
